

Fairlington Green Recycle Information

New - Single Stream Recycling Effective Wednesday October 18, 2017

Residents will no longer need to separate their mixed paper and commingled (cans, bottles, plastics, etc.) recyclables. All recyclable items can be placed in the bins together. If the bins are full, put your recyclables in paper bags next to the bins. Cardboard can still be placed next to the bins, therefore leaving space available in the bins for smaller recyclable items. This new recycling program should encourage more recycling and make the process simpler and more convenient for our residents.

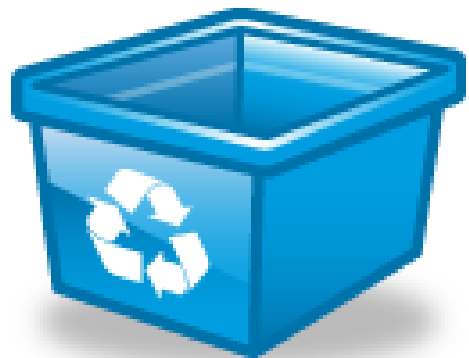
Recycle items are picked up every Wednesday morning. Items may be placed in one of the six locations beginning Tuesday evening once the bins are available for collection. The contractor places the large gray barrels at the six recycling locations late Tuesday afternoon.

The Recycling Locations are:

- 3139/3165 S. Stafford Street at the parking lot curb
- 3207 S. Stafford/4105 S. 32nd Road at the end of the units
- S. Stafford Circle by the unit at 3277 S. Stafford
- 3224/3246 S. Stafford Street at the parking lot curb
- End of the parking lot at 4207 S. 32nd Road
- 4313 S. 32nd Road/3233 S. Utah Street at the rear of the units on the parking lot sidewalk

“WHAT TO RECYCLE?”

What to Recycle?

1. **Mixed Paper:** newspaper, magazines, inserts, office paper, brochures and other glossy paper, paper bags, self adhesive paper, post-it-notes, paper and hardcover books, catalogs, cereal and food boxes, telephone books, envelopes (with and without windows), and "junk mail"
 - Do not recycle paper plates and napkins or other items contaminated with food.
 - Remove liners in cereal and food boxes
2. **Corrugated Cardboard - pizza boxes and cardboard boxes**
3. **Commingles:** aluminum cans, metal food cans, glass bottles and jars, milk and juice cartons, plastic bottles and jugs (#1-7), wide-mouth plastic containers, aluminum foil and aluminum trays, empty aerosol cans, wire hangers, rigid plastics
 - Empty and rinse all food and liquids from plastics, aluminum beverage and other metal cans (removing the label is unnecessary).
 - Do not recycle plastic food trays and cups, clamshell containers, light bulbs, mirrors, Styrofoam, window glass, ceramics, batteries, pottery, cookware (pots and pans), broken glass, or anything else made of glass.
4. **Recycling Bins**
 - Food contamination can cause an ENTIRE batch of commingled recyclables to be rejected!
5. **Collection:** Recycling service will be provided on each week on your designated day (or days) for separated newspapers, cardboard and for commingles (see acceptable and non-acceptable materials above). The Contractor will take all suitable materials placed in proper recycling bins to a recycling recovery center.
